Brown County Parks report:

- The parks department was approached by Green Bay Leadership to join forces in funding and installing several bike repair stations along the trail. These stations, if implemented, would include air pumps, bike stand, and tools for simple bicycle repairs.
- Seasonal staff will be starting mid-April, so expect to see them maintaining the trail and enforcing the rules.
- Overall trail attendance has increased this past winter. Woo Hoo!

WI State Trail passes:

The WI State Trail passes bought locally help fund the upkeep of the State trails managed by Brown County Parks. So even if you only walk on the trails, it is still a good idea to buy a pass.
