- Trees and vines are being removed in needed areas along the trail.
- "Pay here" has been painted on the trail near pay stations.
- A bike repair station has been installed behind the old Eve's Supper Club building.
- Trail pass enforcement continues with many tickets being written.
- The centerline of the trail is scheduled to be painted in spring of 2019.
- Expect weekly sporadic closures under 172 as WI DOT is doing bridge maintenance.
