Brown County Parks report from Matt Kriese:

1. Trail Passes Required - As a reminder a daily or annual pass is required prior to using the trail with bikes, inline skates, skateboards or horses for anyone age 16 and over. The trail fees are ONLY used for specific trail maintenance and operation costs in Brown County. Please support the trail and purchase your pass. Visit our online store at www.browncountyparks.org and click on "Purchase Pass".
2. New for 2021 - Auto Pay Stations were installed at Voyageur Park access and the trailhead at the corner of Porlier and Adams Street. Daily passes can be purchased with credit cards now. Annual passes may be purchased from the machine as well, however you will need to redeem the printed receipt from the machine at the park office to obtain your physical pass. To redeem passes you can either mail the receipt in or stop at our office.
3. Rangers will be cutting trees ash trees along the trail as time permits this winter.

Thank you to Cliff Wall for his well-organized buckthorn removal. Cliff has worked diligently both himself and with groups to ensure buckthorn does not choke out other vegetation which is very much in line with our mission of enriching the quality of life through users enjoying the visual vitality of the trail.
