Brown County Parks report from Nikki Hilker:

- John worked with Highway to add crusher dust to a stretch by Duester Road where it was badly rutted and bumpy
- Exercise stations have new playground chips in all of them
- Dave removed the plexiglass on the exercise station trail signs and cleaned them up so you can read them in addition to fixing one of the stations equipment
 - I'll be meeting with someone from St. Vincent about updating the signs and equipment
- Dave and Trey will be working on trimming the trail, especially by signs and intersections over the next couple of weeks (Mountain Bay included), along with other landscape/hardscape projects
- John will be mowing the trails with the tractor hopefully by the 2nd week of June. We are planning on renting the big reach arm mower tractor in August for a month
- Wild parsnip was sprayed from Porlier down to Heritage. Some plants were likely missed but will hopefully go through once more in the next week or two and spray them again, then follow up in later summer to chop off the flower heads before going to seed of any remaining plants
