Brown County Parks report:

Brown County Parks should have 2022 WI State Trail passes for sale by mid-December. Check Parks website or call the office. They make a great Christmas gift.

No major projects occurred on the trail in the last month, as is typical this time of year.

The trail will once again be plowed from the city of Green Bay to Heritage Road.

The portion of Heritage Road and south to Greenleaf remains snow covered for a variety of uses, whether fat tire biking, snowshoeing, general walking, etc.

The portion of the trail south of Greenleaf will continue to be open for snowmobiles, weather permitting.
